⁷ <u>JOUR355</u>: The ACC returned due to the syllabus stating 12 hours of work per week for a 4-credit/6-week summer course rather than 20 hours of work per week.

⁸ <u>FAIR235D</u>: The ACC returned and requested further explanation in syllabus of requirements to pass the class for S/U graded course. The ACC suggested removing book title in the course description.

⁹ <u>ESCI536</u>: The ACC returned and requested the syllabus resemble a face-to-face course, e.g. remove references of "remote" and "asynchronous" terminology.
