- 4:01 CALL TO ORDER: ATC Chair Derek Moscato called the meeting to order at 4:01 pm, welcoming a total of 17 attendees (roster attached).
  
- 4:03 Justina Brown and AJ Barse of ATUS presented an overview of AI issues on campus, including academic integrity/AI issues. Some potential software solutions for faculty were presented. These newer tools were examined in terms of pros/cons such as utility, cost, and integration with existing systems. The dialogue also included discussion with ATC members of the advantages and disadvantages of AI/integrity software solutions for faculty, including the fact that such applications have a relatively higher detection failure or evasion rate compared to non-AI checkers of academic work. This necessitates a more hands-on and cautious usage of these newer tools for AI by faculty members. ATC members agreed that this discussion should continue into the spring.
